#### PRESIDENT'S LETTER

As my tenure as president of the Society comes to an end, I am pleased to report that we now have a conceptual plan for expansion of our museum and research library to work with . This plan, several years in the making, was presented to our members at our annual meeting in May, shown below. This plan effectively addresses our current and future needs: More exhibit space, increased library work space, secure controlled storage space and elevator access to the second floor of the current museum.

Work has already begun on the next phase which is to work with the Waukegan Park District to create a funding plan. We anticipate that we will need significant support from our members, friends and other sources. To date, our Historic Preservation Fund has received slightly more than \$10,000 for this project. We are also investigating the option of constructing the addition in stages in order to spread the cost over a longer time frame.

At our annual meeting we also reviewed this year's activities, and elected Officers and Directors. We welcomed Harry E. Came as President and new Directors, Matt Crabbe and Erica Burt.


